CHECKLISTS




PRE-SHOW CHECKLIST

- Turn off & move ghost light
- Check that the deck crew has swept & mopped the stage
- Check the backstage areas for cleanliness & organization
- Post the sign-in sheets In Green Room
- Open dressing rooms & entries
- See that cast and crew members have initialed the sign-in sheet by the prearranged time and call any who may be late
- Check placement of set pieces
- Check the placement of props, on stage and on prop tables. Check that prop table lights are functioning
- Check the functioning of the monitors
- Check that the light crew has successfully completed dimmer check
- Check the functioning of the sound system & mics with the sound crew
- Check to see that all doors in the backstage area are open or closed, locked or unlocked as appropriate
- Check the positioning of the curtain, if used
- Turn off work lights
- Open the house 30 mins prior to curtain
- · Allow no one to enter the stage area after the house is open
- Give calls thirty minutes, fifteen minutes, and five minutes prior to the
- scheduled time for curtain, give calls in person to avoid any communication problems
- FIVE MINUTES UNTIL PLACES
- Check to see that crew members are going to their stations at the fiveminute call
- Check with the House Manager via Booth to see how conditions are in the house, if the lobby is clear or if the audience is still arriving
- Call places at three minutes
- Check to see that all crews are ready and on headsets
- Check with ASM to see that each actor is in their places
- Begin the show if everyone and everything is ready

- · Check that props were checked-in
- · Check that costumes were checked-in
- Post cast sign-out
- Turn lights off In green room & dressing rooms

- Lock prop room
- Lock costumes
- Turn on Ghost light

INFORMATION

Open auditions will take place November 14, 2020 with callbacks following the next day. There will also be an invite audition from online submissions the following weekend. Holding auditions this early will be beneficial to make casting adjustments as needed and finalize the cast before entering the 2021 year. We reserve the rights to change and update these policies & consequences throughout the duration of the show

As a company member I will abide by the following policies:


- · Arrive to call times at least 15 minutes early for rehearsals
- Arrive to call times at least 30 minutes early for performances
- Not eat or chew gum In costume or In the theatre; ONLY water
- Not use my electronic device In dressing rooms or backstage
- Stay quiet when backstage
- Not leave until dismissed
- Call Stage Manager 5 days prior to being absent
 - If It Is an emergency call ASAP
- Sign In to every rehearsal & performance
- Be prepared for rehearsals with all necessary personal Items, script, choreography, pencils, notepad, etc.
- All rehearsals are CLOSED
- No alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or vapor products may be consumed on the premises before and during rehearsals & performances

Consequences:

- The three-strike rule will be Implemented for policy breaking
- After the third strike, the company member will be asked to leave the show Immediately without compensation according to their signed contract

TECH ANNOUNCEMENT

This is an example of what should be said before tech rehearsals so all company members are aware of what will happen:

- Tonight will be a tech rehearsal, which indicates that we will be running through the entire show
- We may have to stop to fix technical elements. If this happens, you will hear the word "hold", which means to pause exactly where you are at and face the front of the stage.
- Please be respectful and patient throughout this process.
- Please be consistent with your timing & blocking. Consistency will help speed the process along.
- Many people must communicate to one another, onstage, offstage, and In the house, so please be quiet.
- Give in's and out's for the night
- No phones or computers in the house
- Don't record any portion of the rehearsal
- No gum, food, or drink in the stands
- If you have any problems dealing with props please talk to the ASM's before the beginning of the rehearsal. In addition, ensure that your props are placed in the appropriate wing.
- Have costumes give notes
- Have director give notes
